

# Personality Game

Advanced

Target Language: **Personality adjectives**

In this game, students make a statement about their personality, and the other students must try to guess the descriptive name for the personality. There are many adjectives that could be used to describe the personality statements, so you may want to award points for different words.

1. The first sheet is a master sheet for the teacher. You should assign a personality for each student. Try to give a personality to all students (when I played some students were left out and they weren't happy)
2. Print out 2 copies of the master sheet- one for the teacher, and one that you cut. Cut out each personality statement (the shape of the grayed out box). Students get one personality box each.
3. Students receive the second page, where they must record the name of each student, the statement they make, and in the bottom box they write down which personality adjective describes the person / statement.
4. It can be really funny if you assign personality adjectives which DO NOT fit the person- but watch out! The students can get offended..... My students knew I was just having fun with them- but you need to make that clear.
